I am a recent graduate of Trinity College Dublin, and I am applying for the position of summer intern with Byrne Wallace. I achieved a 2.1 LLB from Trinity, and am currently undertaking a Masters' Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Leiden in the Netherlands.

My previous work experience includes positions as; a Brand Development Intern (ANNA SCHU), Social Media Marketing Assistant (Distinct Model Management), and Brand Educator (Vita Coco). These positions have allowed me to work on my research, communication, and interpersonal skills.
